# Local Scholarship Handbook

Each year local clubs, organizations, and businesses offer scholarships to deserving JFK Students. In this packet you will find the General Application that can be submitted for most local scholarships. Some scholarships may require a different application than the one in this booklet or have special requirements such as mailing the application to a specific location with a different deadline. You may apply for as many local scholarships for which you are eligible. You must turn in a separate application for each local scholarship you want to be considered for to the JFK Counseling Office. Additional local scholarships may become available throughout second semester. They will be sent out to seniors via Remind. As they become available, Mrs. Carson will e-mail them to students as requested.

## Application Guidelines

1. Application packet **MUST** have a **cover sheet** with the Scholarship Name/Student Name. **Please do not use a folder or hard cover.**
2. Complete the **General Award Application** for each scholarship that is turned into the Kennedy counseling office. Follow the directions carefully.  
*Note: Remember some scholarships may require a different application and may need to be submitted to a different location! Please keep in mind that the essay accompanying each scholarship should be targeted towards the scholarship. A generic essay does not necessarily represent what the scholarship committee is looking for, so you will want to make sure your essay meets the criteria of the scholarship that you are applying to.*
3. Include an unofficial **transcript** for JFK and Norco College. *Please e-mail your counselor for a copy of your transcript and one will be sent to you.*
4. Write your 1–2-page **Personal Essay**. Please attach 1 copy per scholarship.
5. Some scholarships may require **Letters of Recommendation**. Please complete the Letter of Recommendation Student Information Sheet in this book prior to asking your teacher/employer/College Instructor. This will help them to write a glowing letter for you. Allow them 2 weeks to complete the letter.
6. Check your applications carefully and keep a copy for yourself. Application packet should consist of:
  - a. Cover Sheet (Scholarship Name and Student Name)
  - b. General Application OR Application Provided by Sponsor
  - c. Personal Essay
  - d. Unofficial transcripts from JFK and Norco College
  - e. Letter(s) of Recommendation if required.
7. Paperclip packet together. **Do NOT staple or use a presentation folder or hardcover.**
8. Make sure you turn in your application to either JFK Counseling Office or the specified location.
9. Completed General Application Local Scholarship applications are due to the **Counseling office by 3:00 p.m. on or before Friday, February 6, 2026.**

## THE PERSONAL ESSAY

### **The following suggestions may be helpful to students when writing the scholarship essay.**

Plan carefully.

Format the essay – typed, font size = 12, double-spaced, margins = 1 inch, no more than 2 pages.

Write an essay that will provide a comprehensive picture of who you are.

- Introduce yourself by providing background information.
- Briefly state your academic accomplishments (ex. Honors/Norco College /AVID student, academic awards).
- State your extracurricular activities, jobs, or volunteer work.
- Explain how these activities and accomplishments have shaped your life.
- State your future goals and objectives and include where you plan to go to college as well as your major field of study (if you have decided).
- State your financial needs – explain why the scholarship will help you fulfill your dreams.
- Be sincere and honest.

Express appreciation to the agency for offering money to a deserving student.

After you have completed writing your best essay, let someone read it who can be objective and will not mind offering his/her honest opinion.

Don't wait until the night before the due date to compose your essay. Prepare it in advance and keep it on your computer so it can be revised.

**\*\*Keep in mind that 1 generic essay may not target all the scholarships. Write specifically for your audience. For example, if the scholarship is looking for a student that wants to be a scientist, you may want to discuss your experiences within the science field.**

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## **CALIFORNIA RETIRED TEACHERS' ASSOCIATION SCHOLARSHIP (CalRTA: Corona-Norco Chapter)**

### **Eligibility**

- The student must have declared an intention to graduate from college with a bachelor's degree or better.
- The student must have attended a Corona or Norco high school at least during the senior year.
- The student must maintain an acceptable level of scholastic achievement (minimum 3.0 GPA.)
- The student may show financial need determined through the application, or letters of recommendation, or personal essay, or an interview.
- The student must have maintained an acceptable school and community record of activities and service.
- **The student should preferably be entering the field of Education.**

### **Include in Application**

- General Award Application sheet (included in this packet)
- Personal Essay – *Should include the following: Scholastic achievements, citizenship, leadership, personality, potential achievement, community involvement, and financial need.*
- 2 Letters of Recommendation
- Copy of JFK and Norco College unofficial transcripts

- Return application to the JFK Counseling Office by Friday, February 6, 2026.
- The JFK scholarship committee will select 5 applications to be reviewed by the CalRTA Scholarship Committee.
- Interviews will be scheduled February - April to select a winner.

### **Award**

## **CORONA-NORCO MANAGEMENT ASSOCIATION AWARD**

### **Eligibility**

- Serve or work within a leadership role on campus
- Involvement in community service organizations & participate in extra-curricular activities
- Demonstrate financial need
- Career goal and post-secondary education oriented
- Minimum 3.0 GPA

### **Include in Application**

- General Award Application sheet (included in this packet)
- CNMA Application sheet- *E-mail school counselor for the application*
- 1-page Personal Essay – *Should include the following: Which school you plan to attend, scholastic and past achievements, volunteer and leadership opportunities, future goals, and career path, and how this scholarship will assist you in obtaining these future goals.*
- A statement/explanation for financial need (you may use the included form or provide your own)
- 2 Letters of Recommendation
- Copy of JFK and Norco College unofficial transcripts

### **Selection**

- Return application to the JFK Counseling Office by Friday, February 6, 2026.

- The JFK scholarship committee will select 3 - 8 applications to be reviewed by the CNMA Scholarship Committee.
- Interviews will be scheduled throughout February - April to select a winner.

#### **Award**

- \$1,000, Number of awards given may vary.

### **WOMAN'S IMPROVEMENT CLUB of CORONA SCHOLARSHIP**

#### **Eligibility**

- Demonstrates financial need
- Qualities of good citizenship and character which include service to their school or community
- Definite higher educational goals
- All genders may apply

#### **Include in Application**

- Woman's Improvement Club Application sheet- *E-mail school counselor for application*
- One-to-two-page Personal Essay addressing the following three areas – 1. *Describe your career plans, goals, objectives, and any other information you feel would be valuable to the selection committee.* 2. *Describe all school service-related activities. Include any service you provide to others in your school. Do not use abbreviations for any organizations listed.* 3. *Your volunteer service in the community.*
- A statement/explanation for financial need (you may use the included form or provide your own)
- 2 Letters of Recommendation with Reference Form (one from a community volunteer leader and the other a member of the high school faculty). Letter should attest to the student's abilities and good character. Letters of Recommendation and Reference form must be submitted in a **sealed envelope**.
- Copy of JFK and Norco College unofficial transcripts

#### **Selection**

- Return application to the JFK Counseling Office by Friday, February 6, 2026.
- The JFK scholarship committee will select 5 applications to be reviewed by the Woman's Improvement Club
- The club will not be conducting interviews. Selection will be based on the applications alone.

- Applicants who wish to continue their education at a community college and may need or require support of someone who believes in their ability will be favorably considered.
- While proof of need must be considered, it is not the defining factor.
- Clear educational and career goals.
- Character, service, leadership.

### **Include in Application**

- RFF Application Form- *E-mail school counselor for application*
- Personal Essay – *Should focus on future goals and reason for making the application (one page)*
- Copy of JFK and Norco College unofficial transcripts
- 2 letters of recommendation

### **Selection**

- Return application to the JFK Counseling Office by Friday, February 6, 2026.
- The JFK scholarship committee will select no more than three (3) applicants to be interviewed
- Interviews will be scheduled throughout February - April to select a winner.

### **Award**

- One (1) \$5,000 will be awarded

## **SOROPTIMIST INTERNATIONAL OF CORONA SCHOLARSHIP**

### **Eligibility**

- Senior **FEMALE** who plans to attend a two (2) or four (4) year college or vocational/business school
- 2.5-3.5 GPA
- Shows strength in community service
- Financial need to continue their education

### **Include in Application**

- General Award Application sheet (included in this packet)
- Personal Essay - *Should include the following: How you have overcame adversities in your life and speak to your personal goals and aspirations.*
- 2 Letters of Recommendation
- A statement/explanation for financial need (you may use the included form or provide your own)
- Copy of JFK and Norco College unofficial transcripts

### **Selection**

- Return application to the JFK Counseling Office by Friday, February 6, 2026.
- The JFK scholarship committee will select up to 8 applications to be interviewed by a panel of Soroptimist members.

### **Award**

- One \$1,000 Scholarship
- Selected candidate will attend an awards luncheon in May 2026 to accept her scholarship.

## **CORONA ROTARY SCHOLARSHIP**

### **Eligibility**

- The applicant should be in the top half of the senior class.

- Proof of financial need.

#### **Include in Application**

- Corona Rotary Application – *e-mail school counselor for the application*
- One Page Personal Essay- *Should include the following: Why would you benefit from the Rotary Scholarship?*
- Copy of JFK and Norco College unofficial transcripts
- 2 letters of recommendation

#### **Selection**

- Return application to the JFK Counseling Office by Friday, February 6, 2026.
- The JFK scholarship committee will select applications to be reviewed by the Corona Rotary Scholarship Committee.
- Interviews will be scheduled throughout February - April to select a winner.

#### **Award**

- \$500-\$1,000; Number of awards given may vary.

### **CORONA – NORCO TEACHERS ASSOCIATION (CNTA)**

#### **Eligibility**

- Parent/guardian member of CNTA or student interested in the field of teaching
- Must have declared an intention to graduate from college with a Bachelor's Degree or better
- Attended a CNUSD high school at least during the entire senior year, and received grades from each semester.
- Shows financial need that is determined through interview and letter
- Maintains an acceptable activity record in school and community, and scholastic achievement
- Minimum 2.0 GPA

#### **Include in Application**

- CNTA Scholarship Application – *E-mail school counselor for the application*
- List of school and community activities by grade level
- List of honors or awards received in high school
- 2 Letters of Recommendation
- Personal Essay
- Copy of JFK and Norco College unofficial transcripts

#### **Selection**

- Return application to the JFK Counseling Office by Friday, February 6, 2026.
- JFK Scholarship committee will select 1 student to be interviewed
- If interviewed, you will need to bring a copy of your acceptance letters as well as a SAR report (obtained after completing your FAFSA).
- CNTA Committee will review, interview, and make final selection

#### **Award**

- One award will be granted. Amount varies.

#### **Eligibility**

- Exemplifies leadership on the John F. Kennedy Middle College campus
- Demonstrates financial need
- Demonstrates academic growth
- Clear goals for pursuing post-secondary education

**Include in Application**

- General Award Application sheet (included in this packet)
- One page essay outlining leadership achievements, scholastic achievements including GPA, future plans
- 2 Letters of Recommendation
- Copy of JFK and Norco College unofficial transcripts

**Selection**

- JFK Scholarship committee will select 4-6 students for interview
- Interviews will be scheduled throughout March - April to select a winner.

- A one-page written statement describing their time playing for CGSA and what leadership skills and self-confidence they gained from their experience.
- 2 Letters of Recommendation
- Copy of JFK and Norco College unofficial transcripts

**Award**

**CATHOLIC DAUGHTERS OF THE AMERICAS/Court St. Joseph #1420 - Corona****Eligibility**

- Must be a Catholic high school senior registered in a parish in the Corona-Norco area
- Minimum 2.5 GPA
- Enroll in an accredited two or four-year college, trade school, or university in the Fall
- Have financial need

#### **Include in Application**

- CDA application – *E-mail school counselor for application*
- Personal Essay – *Write about your ultimate goals, what parish you are registered with and specifics about your involvement in school/community activities.*
- 2 Letters of Recommendation: Priest/Teacher/Employer/Club Advisor/Work Supervisor

## **ALIKIAN-ROSSELLI BUSINESS LEADER SCHOLARSHIP AWARD**

### **Eligibility**

- Minimum 2.5 GPA
- Planning to pursue a Business Degree at a four-year university next year

### **Include in Application**

- General Award Application sheet (included in this packet)
- Personal Essay – *Should include the following: Information regarding involvement in school, community, church related activities, organizations and clubs to which you belong to. Also include goals/plans for the future.*
- 300-word essay on why you are pursuing a business degree and how this scholarship would benefit you
- 2 Letters of Recommendation
- Copy of JFK and Norco College unofficial transcripts

There are several different types of scholarships including college, military, regional, national, and local. Students should apply for as many scholarships as they are eligible. If you fail to meet one or more of the criteria indicated by an association, then do not apply for that scholarship.

Scholarships that fit your major and personality can be found on the California Colleges website.

It is recommended that students narrow their college search to four to six colleges and contact those institutions for information on their available grants, scholarships, and financial aid programs. Keep in mind that no matter what financial status you have, most colleges will not consider you for a scholarship unless you have filled out the FAFSA (even if you do not qualify for financial aid). Many schools will have full-ride scholarships available for some majors. Remember to look for private and out of state colleges to find the best financial aid package for you. More information on this subject can be found on the JFK website under Guidance and Scholarships.
