

Suggested Admission Guidelines For Acceptance Into Kennedy Middle College: - Minimum GPA of 2.00 in all classes, (Minimum 2.0 GPA is required to take college classes) - Desire and commitment to complete college classes. - In addition, factors such as motivation, attendance, discipline, maturity level, academic potential, and interest level will be considered in the selection process. In addition to completing the application, candidates who do not meet the minimum Suggested Admission Guidelines may be asked to submit teacher/counselor recommendations and/or attend an interview with an administrator. The administrator will carefully consider the student's interview along with teacher/counselor recommendations to determine if special circumstances exist which warrant special consideration for admission into the program. Students with special needs (English Learners, Students with IEP's, 504 Plans etc.) will be considered for admission based on their ability to be successful in Norco College courses.
